The staff at Albert Community School is committed to supporting our students pursuit of academic excellence. To that end we have established the following goals for the 2014-15 school year.

**Reading:** 80% of students in grades 1 to 8 will achieve a full year growth or be at grade level in their reading ability.

**Numeracy:** 75% of our students will achieve 1 level of growth in the DNA for grades 1 to 8. 80% of students will achieve 1 level of growth on either the ANA (Albert Numeracy Assessment) or Ministry directed assessments (found on blackBoard).

**Attendance:** Increasing our student attendance 5% by June 2015.



### Albert Eagle Clothing "Spiritwear"

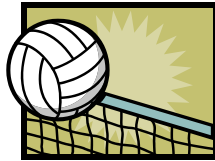
